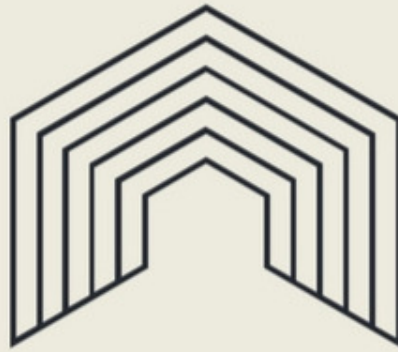

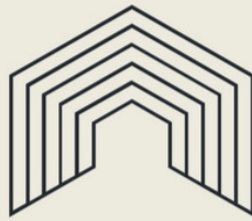

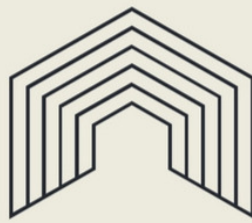
THE ASYMMETRIC SHOCK

The Centre for Specialization in Business and Innovation of Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad will be holding the first of its kind - 'The Asymmetric Shock', a national level model World Economic Forum, in Hyderabad on 3rd and 4th March, 2018. The event shall replicate the sessions of the World Economic Forum.

ABOUT THE EVENT

'Asymmetric Shock' signifies the happening of an unexpected event, that as a crisis, affects one or more economies more significantly than the rest. This can create big problems for policymakers if they are trying to set a macroeconomic policy, which works for both the area affected by the shock directly, or other areas affected indirectly.

'Asymmetric Shock' encapsulates the functioning of the World Economic Forum. The Forum comprises of delegates from countries all over the world who will discuss and deliberate on topics of economic interests. Candidates are expected to register either as single or double delegations. Based on the outcome of the discussion, recommendations will be framed in the mutual interest of all participating members.

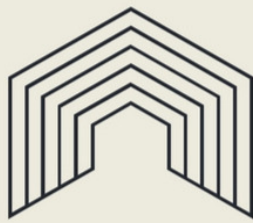


THE ASYMMETRIC SHOCK

STRUCTURE OF THE EVENT

The Asymmetric Shock runs on the lines of a Model United Nations (MUN) however, with certain variations.

1. The candidates shall act as the delegates of the respective members or partners allotted to them. Each of the candidates shall represent their best economic interests.
2. The Agenda for discussion shall be provided to the candidates. It shall present an urgent economic crisis affecting the countries.
3. The Forum is the platform of discussion of the Agenda, at the end of which, recommendations shall be presented. The Forum shall be headed by the Executive Board comprising of the Chair and the Co-Chair. The discussion shall be presided over by Moderators.
4. There shall be four Sessions of the Forum as follows:
 - 4.1. The First Session shall be an open caucus. Each delegate shall be allotted 3-5 minutes to make the representation, regarding the Agenda.
 - 4.2. The second and the third Session shall comprise of deliberation on the Agenda, with representations and recommendations from each delegate for debate and discussion.
 - 4.3. The Fourth Session shall be the concluding session. Each delegate may choose to make closing remarks and establish their position with regards to the Agenda.

DATE, TIME & VENUE

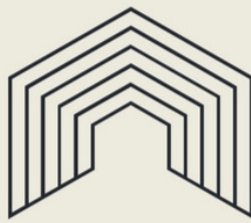
1. The Event shall be conducted at Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad on the 3rd and 4th of March, 2018.
2. The Event shall extend over a period of two days and one night. The candidates are to stay overnight for the finals followed by declaration of the result.

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

1. Each candidate shall be provided with accommodation in the Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad campus for one night. The stay may be extended for an extra night, on chargeable basis, with prior notice to the Organisers.
2. Each candidate would be provided with breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner.
3. Each candidate shall be provided transportation to and from Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad, campus in accordance with the candidate's travel itinerary.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

- The First, Second and Third Best Delegate shall be awarded Cash Prizes, Merchandise and Trophies worth up to Rs. 75,000. In addition, each candidate shall receive Participating Certificates and the Winners shall receive Certificates of Appreciation.

REGISTRATIONS

1. There would be individual online registrations. The candidates shall be selected on the basis of previous experience of MUN, Parliamentary Debates etc.
2. The selected candidates must make an online payment of a total fee of Rs. 2000 inclusive of accommodation, food, travel and registration. Double delegations will have to pay a fee of Rs. 3800, inclusive of the above. The payment must be made within 1 week of the announcement of the first selection list.

1. Registration Opens - 18th January, 2018.
2. Last Date of Registrations - 2nd February, 2018.
3. Announcement of First Selection List - 5th February, 2018.
4. Last Date for Payment - 11th February, 2018.
5. Release of Agenda - 12th February, 2018.
6. Date of Event - 3rd & 4th March, 2018.
