- ❖ The composition should be submitted in MS Word format, with the font style Times New Roman, font size 12 and line spacing of 1.5.
- ❖ Word limit for the Short Story is 650 words.
- ❖ The submission should be original and unique. No plagiarism in any form shall be accepted.
- ❖ All entries should be mailed to inkpot@slsh.edu.in by 6:00pm 05/08/2017.
