Sub: Recommendation for Jeevan Raksha Padak Series of Awards-2021.

05 JUL 2021

Respected Madam/Sir,

Jeevan Raksha Padak series of awards are given for meritorious acts of humane nature in saving the life of a person in incidents like drowning, accidents, fire incidents, electrocution, landslides, animal attack and rescue operation in mines etc. As the name of the award suggests, the award is given to a rescuer for saving someone's life. It is given in the following three categories:-

1. **Sarvottam Jeevan Raksha Padak**- awarded for conspicuous courage in saving life under circumstances of very great danger to the life of the rescuer.
2. **Uttam Jeevan Raksha Padak**- awarded for courage and promptitude in saving life under circumstances of great danger to the life of the rescuer.
3. **Jeevan Raksha Padak**- awarded for courage and promptitude in saving life under circumstances of grave bodily injury to the rescuer.

The recommendations for the awards are to be forwarded in the enclosed proforma (**Annexure-I**). A character and antecedents verification certificate is also required to be furnished in each case in the enclosed proforma (**Annexure-II**). **It may be noted that the recommendations for this award are considered by Awards Committee within a period of two years from the date of performance of the gallant act. Therefore, for the year 2021, any recommendation in respect of which the date of performance of the act falls prior to 1st October 2019 should not be forwarded to this Ministry for consideration.**

The recommendations for the Jeevan Raksha Padak series of Awards can also be sent through the online portal designed by Ministry of Home Affairs, (URL: www.jrp.mha.gov.in). The recommendations should contain all relevant details specified in the format available on the above said website, including a citation in narrative form (maximum 200 words), clearly bringing out the sequence-wise details of the incident as well as the specific role/contribution of the person (rescuer).

It may be noted that the recommendations for Jeevan Raksha Padak series of awards for the year 2021 are to be sent latest by 30th September 2021. For online recommendations a user login I.D. and password of each recommending authority will be created. You are therefore, requested to send an email from your official email I.D. to sopub@nic.in in order to get your Login I.D. and Password through email. However, the recommending authorities who have already got login I.D. and Password may use the same login I.D. and Password while sending online recommendations for the year 2021.

All the Universities and their affiliated colleges/institutes are requested to give recommendations to Ministry of Home Affairs on their portal/ website mentioned above.


