

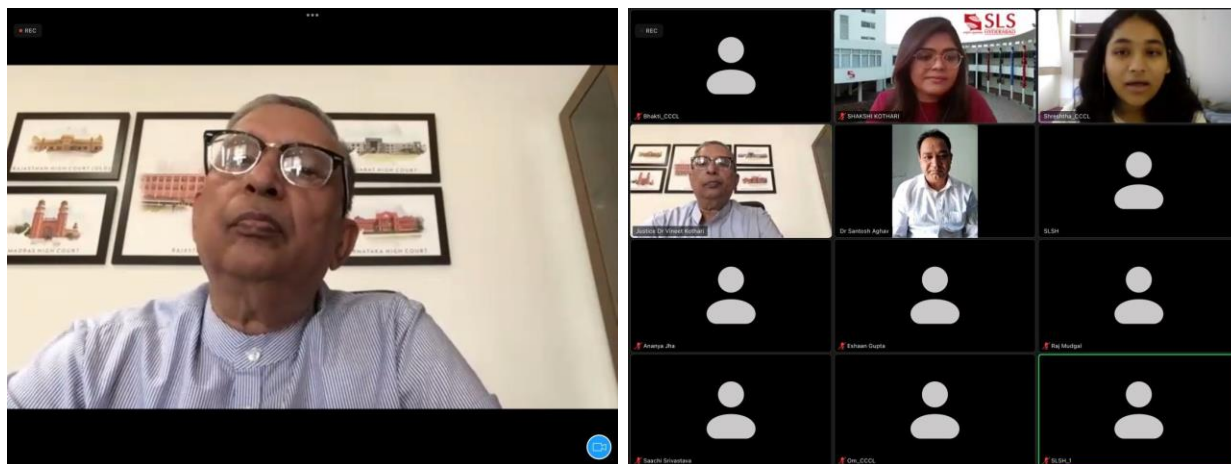
Lecture series on the topic “Mergers and Acquisition” on 6th August 2023:

The Centre for Corporate and Competition Law at Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad, successfully completed its Internal event on the Corporate lecture series on the topic “**Mergers and Acquisition**” on 6th August 2023 (Wednesday), which started from 10:30 AM and ended around 12:30 P.M. The lecture series was led by **CS Tangirala Lalitha Devi**. To enhance the learning experience, the lecture was followed by a ‘Group Discussion’ on a comprehensive problem. The total numbers of participants were a total of 100 interested students. Tangirala Lalitha Devi Ma’am began the event by talking about corporate restructuring, which means making changes in how a company is organized. She explained what Mergers and Acquisitions (M&A) mean, their type, and their benefits too. Finally, she explained the step-by-step process of Mergers and Acquisitions and the similarities between buying and selling companies. The lecture was followed by a Group discussion on a scenario where two companies were thinking about merging. The participants talked about why they should merge and if it might create a monopoly, which is when one company dominates the market. They discussed how the merger could affect the balance of supply and demand in the market. Some were in favour of the merger, while others were against it, considering factors like how well the two companies would work together. The lecture and group discussion ended on a positive note, leaving the students with a sense of achievement.
