# ABSTRACT SUBMISSION



∅ The abstract should not exceed 500 (Five Hundred only) words, and must be accompanied by a cover page, stating the following- Sub-Theme(write “others” in case it is not mentioned in sub-theme); Title of the paper; Name of Author(s); Name of Institute/ Organization; Official Designation; E-mail Address; Postal Address and Contact Number.

∅ The Subject of the Mail should be “Abstract Submission for-Theme-Subtheme-name of author”

∅ The word folder containing the abstract should have the name of the author and title of paper.

∅ Abstract should have minimum three and maximum four Key Words.

∅ The submission should be in word. PDFs and other formats will not be accepted.

∅ Selection of Abstract will be notified on 15 of January 2020

∅ After Selection, a detailed mail regarding the registration process will be sent i.e. Registration Form along with a detailed note concerning the Final-Paper Submission.



# FORMATTING GUIDELINES

- ★ The main text must be in Times New Roman with front size 12 and line spacing 1.5.
- ★ The footnotes must be in Times New Roman, front size 10 with spacing 1.0.
- ★ Endnotes are not suggested. Footnoting reference is mandatory.
- ★ One inch margin should be maintained on all four sides.
- ★ Citation  
Style: Bluebook, 20th Edition.
- ★ The maximum length of the paper shall not exceed 10,000 (Ten Thousand Only) words (including footnotes/ endnotes/annexure/reports/ figures etc.)  
Maximum Word Limit shall be 10,000 (Ten Thousand Words & the Minimum Word Limit shall be 4,000 (Four Thousand Words))

- ★ Registration Details will be intimated after Abstract Selection. The sole decision of selection of final paper shall lie with the Editor and Centre Authorities.
- ★ Plagiarized entries will be liable for rejection. Grammatical & Punctuation mistake will not be overlooked.
- ★ There must not be any copyright issues with the paper sent for the publication purpose i.e. it should not be submitted and published in any other place.
- ★ The authors of selected paper will have to sign an undertaking stating that the paper is not published in any other place and that it is an original piece of work.
- ★ The editors reserve the right to delete or edit any article or part thereof whose content is found to be offensive, defamatory, out rightly unethical, or if it is suggestive of untrue facts of racism, sexual or religious discrimination, illegal or terror, activities etc.
- ★ The best papers of the Seminar will be rewarded and published theme wise, in a book with ISBN Number or as Special issue of Symbiosis Law Journal.
