 A guest lecture on "Phonetics, Book Review, and Citations" and "Inter/Intra-Personal

Communication, Memo/Notice Writing, and Abbreviations" was organised on 7th June 2023. The resource person was Dr Kalapoorna, and she commenced the lecture by introducing students to the fascinating world
