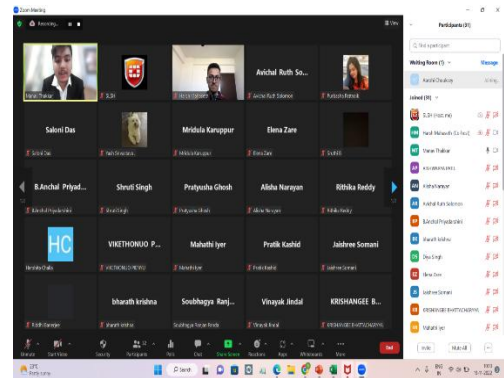
5. ‘BuizzKnow’:

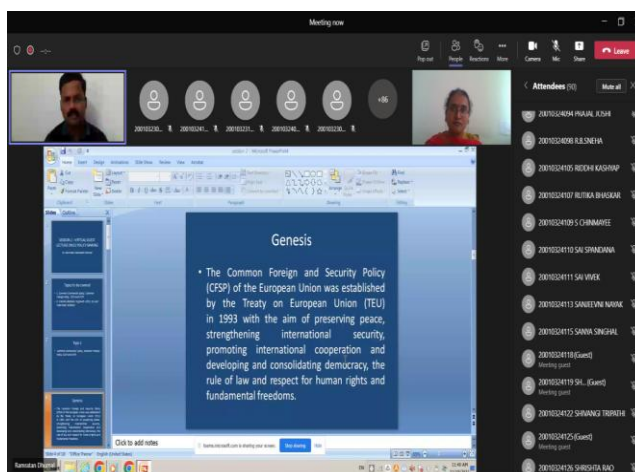
9. Seminar on "Global Perspective of the Changing Dimensions of the Reproductive Rights of Women":

The Legal Aid Centre of Symbiosis Law School Hyderabad conducted a seminar on the topic "Global Perspective of the Changing Dimension of Reproductive Rights of Women" on 26th of November, 2022. The seminar dealt with reproductive and abortion rights and the laws associated with the same. It discussed their impact on women's autonomy and their efficacy in achieving the right to seek safe abortion in India. The seminar was graced with the presence of esteemed speakers like Dr. Manjula Anagami, Prof. Aparna Rayaprol and Mr. Someshwar Wale, who have acquainted the students with issues concerning the enforcement of abortion rights and enhanced their understanding of reproductive rights through a medical perspective and also through legal and sociological aspects of the same.



GUEST LECTURE SERIES:

1. A Virtual Guest Lecture Series was organized for the Course, Principles and Foundations of EU Law and Policy held on 19th November 2022 conducted on EU Policy Making –Mode IV by the eminent Resource Person Dr. Ramratan Dhumal, Assistant Professor, Ajeenkya, D.Y. Patil University, Pune. The Guest Lecture covered various topics on EU policy-making, European Union as an



International Actor, and International Legal Personality. The Series also covered the Constitutional Framework and General Principles of European Union External Action, Common Commercial Policy, Common Foreign Policy, CSSP, and CFSP, also internal obstacles to the growth of EU, EU, and India trade relations. Particularly EU as a Legal Person, specific emphasis on obstacles of EU and India- EU Trade relations topics really required to know for identifying the gaps in the concerned area. The Session extensively discussed and clarified many areas of EU law and Policy.

2. Dr Damian Mather, Principal Lecturer in Law, International Lead and BTC Programme Lead, Manchester Law School, Manchester Metropolitan University, addressed the students of SLS, Hyderabad, on the State of Human Rights in the Contemporary World.
