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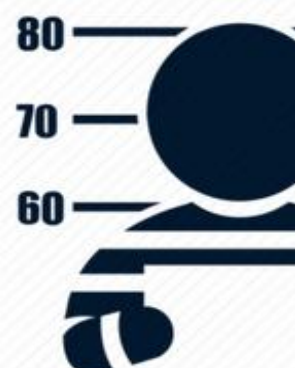


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## **INTRODUCTION – SYMBIOSIS INTERNATIONAL (DEEMED UNIVERSITY) & SYMBIOSIS LAW SCHOOL, HYDERABAD**

**“Symbiosis”**, a scientific term, denotes interaction between two different organisms living in close physical association, typically to the advantage of both or a mutually beneficial relationship between different people or groups. The idea of ‘Symbiosis’ is nurtured by Prof. (Dr.) S. B. Mujumdar, Chancellor Symbiosis International (Deemed University) and prestigious ‘Padma Bhushan’ awardee by Government of India on the principles of the Vedic thought ‘Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam’ which means the ‘World is One Family’. With this stupendous view, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) Pune was established by Prof. (Dr.) S. B. Mujumdar in 1971 and symbiosis got deemed university status in 2002 with the constant efforts, today, Symbiosis comprises of 48 academic institutes imparting teaching, research and training in diverse disciplines. It has students who hail not only from all the states of India but also from 85 different countries.

Among those diverse 48 academic disciplines, Symbiosis Law School (SLS-H) Hyderabad is an institute newly established in year of 2014 inheriting splendid novelty, dynamism and excellence in education of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad is founded on the pillars of expertise, justice and service and is committed to impart quality legal education conforming to acclaimed International Standards.

The NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC), an autonomous body for evaluating and accrediting institutions of higher education in India, established by University Grants Commission (UGC) of India re-accredited Symbiosis International (Deemed University) with Grade 'A' and CGPA of 3.58 on a four point scale. Criminology and Criminal Justice is a vibrant academic field engaged in activities to develop and strengthen the existing Criminal Justice system of the state and benefit of the society for smooth functioning.

Our Centre functions with the objective to work as a resource centre in the field of Criminology and Criminal Justice. Our major areas of work include researching on various fields of Criminology and Criminal Justice and undertaking various activities that enhance students' knowledge. The Centre organizes various seminars, symposiums, conferences, research projects and field works on various sub-fields of Criminology and Criminal Justice. We also organize mid-career professional training programs for the Criminal Justice stakeholders. We act as a nodal agency to the government and underprivileged section to find solutions for various criminal justice issues by conducting collaborative research with International Research Agencies and Researchers.

Recently, the Centre also conducted a two-week Research Internship with Tribal Research Centre, Nilgiri Districts, Ooty, Tamil Nadu. During this period the students conducted a detailed study among six Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups of Nilgiri Hills. Arising out of the said research trip, the Centre will be publishing a comprehensive book as well as a report, complete with recommendations, to be sent to the Government of Tamil Nadu and Government of India.

- Provide knowledge about the radical view of crime and deviance
- The applications of forensic science
- Provide basic practical knowledge on the various investigations supporting forensic science

## Syllabus Outline for Fundamentals of Criminology

### **Introduction**

This session would mainly focus on the basic understanding of the concept of criminology, about how crimes take place in various segments of the society and also on the grievous nature of the types of crimes.

### **Schools of Criminology**

Elaborates on the various school of thoughts related to the study of criminology.

### **Sociological Theories on Crime**

Provides basic understanding about the crime and deviance from the sociological theories such as Concentric circle theory, Community social disorganization and crime theory by Sampson & Groves, Crime and economic conditions theory by Guerry & Quetelet, Gender, power and crime theories by Adler, Daly, Lind & Messerschmidt and so on.

### **Psychological Theories on Crime**

Emphasis on the three important theories of crime such as

- Theories of personality
- Theories of learning
- Theories of Motivation.

## **Radical Criminology**

Analysis on the new and radical perspectives of criminology such as Early Marxist views of crime by Bonger, Lower proletariat, class, state and crime by Quinney, Turk's theory of criminalization, Critical criminology by Taylor, Walton & Young and so on.

## **Syllabus Outline for Fundamentals of Forensic Science**

### **Extensive Crime Scene Investigation**

The steps and procedures involved in a Crime Scene Investigation from theoretical aspects as well as practical perspective which would involve field investigation upon a crime scene created by our resource personnel.

### **Finger Print Examination**

Provides basic understanding fingerprint analysis and knowledge regarding the basic approaches.

### **Polygraph and Brain Electrical Oscillation Signature Profiling**

Provides basic understanding about the Polygraph and Brain Electrical Oscillation Signature Profiling and its applications.

**Duration of Course** : 36 Hours (6 Days)

### **Learning Outcomes**

This course will benefit the students in understanding key concepts of criminology and Forensic Science and would especially benefit the students who in future would be working in the field of Criminal law. This programme would also help them in sensitizing the need and importance of criminology and forensic science.

### **Selection Process**

The participants will be selected on the basis of their **Statement of Interest**. The number of participants is restricted to only **150** for the programme.

- Seventy five seats are reserved for the students of Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad and
- Seventy five seats for the participants from outside institutes.
